Protecting members from unsafe working conditions and representing those who have been injured on the job is an essential role for union officers, staff, stewards and activists.

Taught by worker health and safety experts from UCLA LOSH, this stimulating class examines workplace hazards, government regulations, and organizing strategies for safe working conditions.

Students will learn to identify hazards, use Cal/OSHA effectively and build coalitions and Health and Safety Committees.

Topics Include

- Exposure to hazards - chemicals, unsafe equipment and working conditions, ergonomic risks, stress, others
- Negotiating health and safety contract language
- Actions to improve working conditions - involving workers in Health and Safety Committees, grievances, and surveys
- When and how to file a Cal/OSHA complaint
- What to do if workers are injured on the job
