Minutes for Academic Rank Committee meeting – April 24, 2006

Members attending: Linda Cole, Karl Gary, Larry Pogoler, Susan Silvera, and Lourdes Brent

Member absent: Lorraine Megowan

The meeting commenced at 2:55 p.m.

Minutes for the March 23, 2006 meeting were approved as written.

After discussion, the Committee voted to review applications for academic rank on the agenda pending review and approval of absent member Lorraine Megowan.

Subsequently, L. Megowan read all documents pertaining to the applications for academic rank for all of the applicants, and concurred with the recommendations of the other Committee members, i.e., Karl Gary and Joyce Reiley were approved for the rank of Associate Professor; Roxann Dalrymple, Renee Madyun, and John Cavanaugh were approved for Assistant Professor; (they will be sent letters advising them that they can immediately apply for Associate Professor); Chini Johnson was approved for Professor. The application for Melvin Taylor for Professor of Real Estate was also reviewed. Since he was granted Associate Professor in May of 2005, he will be eligible for the rank of Professor in said discipline in May of 2010.

The issue of academic rank in multiple disciplines was tabled until the next Committee meeting.

Lourdes Brent and Larry Pogoler compared lists of the unverified which they had both revised. L. Brent will revise the letter distributed to faculty members with unverified academic rank earlier in the Spring 2006 semester. L. Pogoler will give a list of the unverified to Karl Gary, who will place letters in the appropriate faculty mailboxes.

Members of the Academic Rank Committee whose terms are expiring at the end of this academic year (Linda Cole, Lorraine Megowan, and Karl Gary) were reminded to submit their names for candidacy for this Committee to a representative from the Senate Nominations Committee. Academic Senate elections are scheduled for May 23, 24, and 25, 2006.
