Certification of these units is not automatic and must be requested. Students must see a counselor to have records evaluated for certification. Each area, A through E, may be certified individually when completed. Course may be used in only one area. A student who does not meet certification requirement will be evaluated by the State University and may be required to complete additional General Education courses.

Lower Division Major Requirements: In addition to the General Education pattern, students transferring to the CSU may complete Lower Division Major Requirements at LATTC. Visit the University Transfer Center, ST-203 or consult with a counselor for a list of these courses.

(Students must complete a minimum of 60 semester units of transferable credit unless they were eligible to be admitted as freshmen.)
