- Maintain all electrical safety records as required by OSHA.
- Works alone on all types of maintenance repair, electrical repair, and installation.

Working procedure is as follows:

- Makes various repairs to shop equipment and does general and finish carpentry.
- Works with gas welding and cutting torches; electric welding on a variety of work.
- Maintains and repairs water, oil, steam, air, and gas lines; fire and water pumping system; fork truck maintenance; and all types of electrical work.
- Maintains required housekeeping of work area and observes all safety rules.
- Performs other tasks and duties as assigned.

Tools & materials used:

- Uses sledgehammers, drills, crowbars, block and tackle, chain falls, drill presses, jack saws, wrenches, electrical tools, gas and electric cutting and welding equipment, plumbers and pipe-fitters equipment and other miscellaneous hand tools.
- Works on a variety of machines and equipment in and around plant. Works with several lubricants and chemicals throughout the plant.

- Knowledge of 110V, 230V, 480V, and 24V DC.
- Thorough knowledge of electrical/electronic components and equipment including the use of special instruments for diagnostic purpose.
