Requirements:	<p>Skills Requirements: Know and understand manual and automatic transmission in driving trucks and service vehicles; Understand how to use the following equipment: Power Tools Hand Tools; Drain Cleaning Equipment Ladders; Welding and Cutting Tools, Shovels; Picks and other Digging Tools. Valid California Drivers License Pass Auto Insurance Requirements.</p> <p>Job Description: Responsible for condition of truck and truck stock; assisting Technician on jobs, and general upkeep of the Service Center and Warehouse. Purchasing personal tools to meet the requirements of the job as a technician, studying and passing the tests required to move to the next level and eventually passing the standards test and going into a truck. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Keep trucks clean inside and out; Keep tools clean and in good usable condition including cleaning the snake cables after each use; Keep truck stock organized. Check material boxes every morning and put new material on truck; Keep truck in good operating condition by checking oil, other fluids, and tires once a week. Under the supervision of Technician, assist with jobs at the level of the individual trainee. This includes, but is not restricted to digging, working in or near sewage, and cleaning up debris. When in the Local Service Center, help in Warehouse as needed, keep the parking lot clean and free of nails and screws, sweep, vacuum and clean the warehouse, kitchen, offices and bathrooms. Empty all trash cans. Once Apprentice/Trainee has enough experience as determined by the Branch Manager and the Service Technician, he/she will run the truck on the Technician's day off (no more than two days a week) and during Technician vacation. The trainee MUST take and pass test one within the first 60 days of employment. If he/she does not pass they will be given an opportunity to retake the test within the next 20 days, but before 90 days. If the test is not passed with an 80% or better, the trainee will be terminated. Other duties as may be assigned. The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, crawl in low and small areas; use hands to finger; handle or feel objects, tools or controls; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl; and talk and hear. The employee frequently is required to taste or smell; the employee is occasionally required to sit. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 50 pounds, frequently lift and/or move up to 100 pounds, and occasionally lift and/or move more than 100 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.</p>
