Distinguished SPEAKERS



Laphonza Butler
Former U.S. Senator, CA

A trailblazing figure in American politics, Senator Laphonza Butler was appointed to complete the term of the late Senator Dianne Feinstein, making history as a dynamic and influential voice in the U.S. Senate. Throughout her distinguished career, she has served as a trusted advisor to top elected officials, including Vice President Kamala Harris and during Secretary Hillary Clinton's presidential campaign — championing transformative public policies grounded in justice, equity, and fairness for all communities.

Prior to her Senate appointment, Senator Butler led EMILY's List as president, becoming the first Black woman to helm the organization dedicated to electing Democratic pro-choice women to office. She also served as president of SEIU Local 2015, California's largest labor union, where she advocated for the rights and dignity of long-term care workers across the state.

Recognized by President Barack Obama as a "Champion of Change," Senator Butler's leadership continues to inspire a new generation of advocates and public servants committed to creating a more inclusive and just society.. Senator Butler is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations and has served as a director of the Board of Governors of the Los Angeles branch of the Federal Reserve System, as well as a member of the University of California Board of Regents.

Senator Butler holds a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from Jackson State University and has held numerous leadership roles, including as board member for the National Children's Defense Fund and the Bay Area Economic Council Institute, and as a fellow at the MIT Community Innovators Lab.



**Sonya Christian, PhD.
Chancellor, California Community Colleges**

Dr. Sonya Christian recently served as the sixth Chancellor of the Kern Community College District, a position she held beginning in July 2021. Her three-decade career in education began within the Kern district, where she served as a mathematics faculty member, Division Chair, and Dean of Science, Engineering, Allied Health, and Math at Bakersfield College. From 2013 to 2021, she served as the 10th President of Bakersfield College—one of the colleges overseen by the Kern district.

Dr. Christian has consistently championed equity, student success, and collaborative leadership. Her approach emphasizes distributed leadership and the collective effort of faculty, staff, and administrators. She believes that sustainable change is rooted in shared ownership and community, allowing transformational work to scale and last.

Her commitment to improving student outcomes has led her to several key statewide and national leadership roles. She spearheaded the 2015 coalition that secured philanthropic funding for California's Guided Pathways demonstration project, leading to a \$150 million investment and the creation of the Vision for Success metrics adopted by the Board of Governors in 2017. She also authored the Trailblazers newsletter to share knowledge and support scaling efforts across the state.

During her presidency at Bakersfield College, the institution became one of California's first community colleges to offer a baccalaureate degree as part of a pilot program. Dr. Christian has remained a passionate advocate for expanding four-year degree opportunities at community colleges to increase social and economic mobility, especially in underserved communities.

Her visionary leadership extends to energy and climate resilience. Inspired by NASA's "Dare Mighty Things," Dr. Christian led the establishment of the California Renewable Energy Laboratory—an innovative partnership focused on securing California's clean energy future.

Dr. Christian is a strong proponent of data-driven decision-making and civil discourse to influence policy and resource allocation. She believes in the vital role of community colleges in preparing students for emerging careers, particularly in the green energy sector.

She serves as Chair of the California Community College Women's Caucus, Vice Chair of the Campaign for College Opportunity Board, and a member of the California Community Colleges Asian American Pacific Islander Trustees and Administrators Caucus. Governor Gavin Newsom appointed her to the Student Centered Funding Formula Oversight Committee (2019–2022), and she served as Chair of the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges from 2020 to 2022. Her dedication to institutional quality is evidenced in her work with the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, where she served as chair for two years starting in 2020, having previously served for the commission as Vice-Chair from 2018–2020.



**Sara Hernandez, J.D.
1st Vice President, LACCD Board of Trustees**

As an LAUSD middle school teacher Sara founded a non-profit that identifies low-income students and provides them with exceptional educational opportunity and resources throughout their high school years to get them "to and through college". It was Sara's work with students and their struggles with homelessness, lack of public transit options, housing and food insecurity, navigation of the foster care system, immigration issues, navigating the DACA process and general access of public resources that led Sara to pursue a career in public policy and local government.

After earning a law degree, Sara worked in Los Angeles City Hall, where she led community revitalization efforts through a mix of strategic economic development policies, innovative policy initiatives, and investments in housing, homelessness, transportation, infrastructure and green space.

In 2016, Sara went on to become the Executive Director of Coro Southern California, a national leadership development program that invests in the next generation of emerging leaders. Sara is currently an attorney and a community college instructor teaching Constitutional Law at Valley College.

As an attorney she works regularly with organized labor, community and business leaders in connection with some of the most pressing environmental, land use and housing issues in the region. She has done extensive pro-bono work representing indigent immigrants in asylum proceedings due to the devastating violence in the Northern Triangle and government oppression in Nicaragua. Sara is involved with the Southern Immigrant Freedom Initiative which represents detained immigrants at detention centers throughout the deep South and has assisted immigrant students with the renewal of their DACA status.

Sara holds a Bachelor of Arts in Public Policy from Duke University, a Master in Education from Loyola Marymount University and a Juris Doctor from Loyola Law School. In 2019 she was appointed by State Assembly Speaker Anthony Rendon to serve on the State of California Library Resources Board.

She also serves on the non-profit boards of Young Eisner Scholars, La Plaza de Cultura y Artes and the Loyola Immigrant Justice Clinic.

In her free time, Sara is active in her community both politically and on the grassroots level. She has served as an Assembly District Delegate for the 53rd District, a delegate for the Democratic National Committee and in 2015 Assembly member Miguel Santiago named her Democrat of the Year for the 53rd Assembly District. In 2018, with her neighbors she started a group called DTLA Strong, a resident group focused on community organizing to build political power within the Downtown community. Through extensive organizing and outreach efforts, DTLA Strong has increased voter turnout in the last presidential election by 162% compared to 2016.

Sara currently lives in Boyle Heights with her husband Keith and son Theodore.

Chancellor, LACCD

Dr. Alberto J. Román's extraordinary journey from an immigrant background to Chancellor of the Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) is a powerful testament to the life-changing potential of higher education. His personal connection to this transformative power, rooted in lived experience, fuels his unwavering commitment to educational equity. For over two decades, he has been a dedicated advocate, working tirelessly to create meaningful pathways to success for underserved communities.

Dr. Román's career in education spans a wide range of roles, providing him with a comprehensive understanding of the academic landscape. His experience as a classified employee, faculty member, director of personnel, assistant superintendent, college vice president, vice chancellor of human resources, college president, and now chancellor uniquely positions him to lead with insight and vision. He is deeply committed to expanding access, advancing student success, and driving institutional transformation across LACCD.

As President of East Los Angeles College (ELAC), Dr. Román demonstrated outstanding leadership in boosting enrollment through innovative and community-driven strategies. Acknowledging the barriers many students face in accessing higher education, he implemented comprehensive outreach efforts, including targeted workshops, partnerships with local high schools, CTE and Strong Workforce initiatives, and dynamic marketing campaigns. These efforts emphasized the tangible career and personal development opportunities community colleges provide. Under his leadership, ELAC became one of California's largest community colleges by headcount and a model for increasing student access and participation.

Appointed Chancellor in May 2025, Dr. Román brings a bold, future-focused perspective to LACCD's leadership. His strategic goals include expanding access to quality education, enhancing support for vulnerable student populations, and building strong, lasting partnerships with the community. He works collaboratively with the board of trustees, college presidents, faculty, staff, and stakeholders to ensure the district remains a vital engine for educational and economic opportunity in the region.

Beyond academics, Dr. Román is a passionate advocate for student well-being. He has consistently supported initiatives addressing food and housing insecurity and has championed resources for foster youth, undocumented students, and justice-impacted individuals. His holistic approach to leadership helps create inclusive, student-centered environments where all learners feel seen, supported, and empowered.

Dr. Román holds a doctorate and master's degree in Public Administration from the University of La Verne and a bachelor's degree in Political Science from the University of California, Riverside. His academic credentials and professional experience reinforce his steadfast commitment to educational excellence.

More than a leader, Dr. Román represents the power of possibility. His story embodies the transformative impact of education and serves as a source of inspiration and hope for the communities served by LACCD.

Message from LATTC Alumna, Mayes Rubeo, Emmy Award winning and Oscar nominated Costume Designer

Mayes C. Rubeo is an Emmy Award winning and Oscar nominated costume Designer known for her work on Deadpool & Wolverine (2024), Jojo Rabbit (2019), WandaVision (2021), Apocalypto (2006), Avatar (2009), Thor: Love and Thunder (2022), Thor: Ragnarok (2017), Warcraft: The Beginning (2016), World War Z (2013), Werewolf by Night (2022), Kingdom of the Planet of the Apes (2024), Blue Beetle (2023) and John Carter (2012). Upcoming projects include Taika Waititi's Klara and the Sun (2025).

She was born in Mexico City and went on to train in Fashion and Costume at Los Angeles Trade-Technical College and UCLA. In a design career spanning two decades, she has collaborated with visionary directors

such as Taika Waititi, Mel Gibson, and Zhang Yimou leading studios such as Legendary and Marvel and screen stars including Cate Blanchett, Ruth Negga, Brad Pitt and Andy Lau.

Her early collaborations laid the foundation for a career that has demanded enormous versatility: Mayes began work as an Assistant Costume Designer and Costume Supervisor, gaining experience with Designers Shay Cunliffe, Erica Edell Phillips, Ellen Mirojnick and Enrico Sabbatini, the latter becoming her career mentor. After assisting Shay Cunliffe on Lone Star (1996), Mayes continued to work with the same independent Director-Producer team John Sayles and Maggie Renzi, designing costumes for three of their films: Angeli Armati/Men with Guns (1997), Sunshine State (2002), and Casa de los Babys (2003).

Though budgets were lean, costumes and characters had to feel convincing. These cherished collaborations strengthened Mayes resourcefulness. For Hallmark's movie saga Fidel (2002), Mayes met the challenge of costuming characters from many walks of life and times, to tell a history spanning seven decades. It was Mayes' collaboration with Mel Gibson on Apocalypto (2006), which delivered a powerful image of the lost Mayan civilization, that set her on the path of creating costumes for the epic and otherworldly. Since then she has been known for creating the visual identities of the "Na'vi" people in James Cameron's Avatar (2009), Edgar Rice Burroughs's 100-year-old vision of civilized Mars in Andrew Stanton's John Carter (2012), and for transforming some of the world's most popular video game and comic book worlds into reality on-screen for Duncan Jones' Warcraft (2016), Shawn Levy's Deadpool & Wolverine (2024), Taika Waititi's Thor: Ragnarok (2017), and Marc Forster's World War Z (2013)- for which thousands of people (living and un-dead) were costumed, instead demanded contemporary realism, though still on a global and epic scale.

Mayes continues to bring her costumes into new territories, turning technological and technical challenges into creative opportunities. Her characteristic passion and collaborative spirit have enabled her to successfully lead diverse teams across five continents, merging traditional craft skills with state-of-the-art technology. Mayes' work has featured in international exhibitions, including the Deborah Nadoolman Landis curated Hollywood Costume exhibition (2012) at the Victoria & Albert Museum in London. Three FIDM Exhibitions: 18th Annual Art of Motion Picture Costume Design for the Film Apocalypto, 21st Annual Art of Motion Picture Costume Design for the Film John Carter, and 26th Annual Art of Motion Picture Costume Design for the Film Thor Ragnarok.

Mayes Rubeo is a member of the Academy of Motion Pictures Arts and Sciences, The Costume Designers Guild of America Local 892, and the Scenic Arts Guild.

Graduation REQUIREMENTS

The Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges has authorized the Los Angeles Community College District Board of Trustees to confer the degrees of Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, Associate Degrees for Transfer, Certificates of Achievement, Certificates of Competency, Certificates of Completion, and Baccalaureate Degrees.

Associates Degree

The awarding of an Associate Degree symbolizes a successful attempt on the part of a college to lead students through patterns of learning experiences. Among these are the ability to think and communicate clearly and effectively both orally and in writing; use mathematics and other modes of quantitative reasoning; think critically and understand the modes of inquiry of the major disciplines; be aware of other cultures and times engaging with diverse perspectives; achieve insights gained through experience in thinking about ethical problems; develop the capacity for self-understanding; effectively assess and use information literacy; and engage with civic responsibilities. The District grants the degrees of Associate in Arts and Associate in Science to those students who have completed the subject requirements for graduation and who have maintained a 2.0 average in subjects attempted. Students must also complete the general education, residence, and competency requirements set forth in Title 5 regulations.

To earn an Associate Degree, students must complete the following requirements:

1. Unit Requirements:

A minimum of 60 semester units of course credit in a selected curriculum with at least 18 semester units of study in a major or area of emphasis and at least 21 semester units of study in general education.

2. Residency Requirements:

Students must complete no fewer than 12 units within the Los Angeles Community College District.

3. Scholarship Requirements:

Local Associate Degrees: A "C" (2.0) cumulative grade point average or better in all degree applicable coursework is required in the curriculum upon which the degree is based, including external degree applicable coursework used to meet degree requirements.

Associate Degrees for Transfer: A "C" (2.0) cumulative grade point average in all CSU transferable coursework is required upon which the degree is based, including external CSU transferable coursework used to meet degree requirements.


4. Competency Requirement:

Students must satisfy the requirements for demonstrated competence in reading, written expression, mathematics, and satisfactory completion of an ethnic studies course.

Certificates

Students may be awarded a Certificate of Achievement upon successful completion of a minimum of 16 or more semester units of degree-applicable coursework designed as a pattern of learning experiences designed to develop certain capabilities that may be oriented to career or general education.

Academic HONORS

Distinguished Graduate Award

The Distinguished Graduate Award is one of the most significant and prestigious honors available to the students at Los Angeles Trade-Technical College. They have earned this distinction by maintaining a high grade point average and by completing the requirements for the Distinguished Graduate Award. This honor is bestowed on graduates during the College Commencement.

To be considered for the award, a candidate must:

1. Petition for the Associate Degree
2. Achieve a grade point average of 3.70 or better in all college work completed at LACCD at the time of petition, and is in good standing.
3. Achieve a grade point average of 3.70 or better in all college work completed at LACCD at the end of Fall semester, if graduation requirements will not be completed until the end of the Spring semester.
4. Students who have earned an Associate Degree or equivalent or advanced degree are not eligible for the award.

Graduation Honors

Colleges shall grant academic honors to students who demonstrate excellence in scholarship. This may be accomplished through inclusion on honors lists and/or graduation honors. Honors lists are a recognition of a student's academic excellence during a given semester or series of semesters, while graduation honors are a recognition of excellence over a student's academic career.

To be considered for Graduation Honors, a candidate must meet one of the following requirements:

Summa Cum Laude

1. Grade Point Average of 3.9 or higher, and
2. All degree-applicable coursework taken at LACCD colleges, and
3. A minimum of 24 units completed.

Magna Cum Laude

1. Grade Point Average of 3.7 or higher, and
2. All degree-applicable coursework taken at LACCD colleges.

Cum Laude

1. Grade Point Average of 3.5 or higher, and
2. All degree-applicable coursework taken at LACCD colleges.




